

WHAT IS DONKEY WEEK?

Donkey Week is a wonderful holiday with a difference. As well as meeting many new friends, you also get a chance to have close contact with our donkeys in the beautiful Devon countryside. Throughout the week, there are different excursions to some of our farms that are not usually open to the public. Donkey Week began in 1983 when our late founder Dr Svendsen had an idea to create a holiday for people with a shared interest. The hotels listed in this brochure have agreed to come into the Donkey Week scheme. For each supporter who stays at one of these hotels for the whole of Donkey Week the hotel has kindly agreed to send a donation to the Sanctuary. By staying at one of these hotels, not only do you help to raise funds for the donkeys, you are also sure to meet people with a similar interest. Donkey Week is the ideal holiday for those on their own. Since its humble beginnings visitor numbers have risen from 120 to well over 300. with many people returning year after year.

To make life easier, members of staff will meet you at Exeter St David's Train Station and Exeter Coach Station. They will assist you with your luggage and direct you to your coaches. Coaches will be ready to pick-up supporters from 12 noon on 6th May and will depart for Sidmouth at various times. The last coach for Sidmouth will depart at approximately 4pm.

Throughout Donkey Week, our coaches will pick you up and take you to the various farms. We also have evening entertainment on two of the nights for you to enjoy. There will be a small charge each day to help towards the cost of the coach trips.

Once you have decided where you want to stay, we ask you to deal directly with the hotels; and let us know as soon as you have a confirmed booking. For those attending for the first time we will send a welcome pack nearer the time. It is important for us to know exact numbers for the coaches, catering etc.

We do hope that you will decide to join us for this enjoyable holiday.
