Why we need you to fundraise

It might surprise you to learn that the entry fee only covers the cost of staging the Dawdle for Donkeys event. It is, in fact, your fundraising that gives us the opportunity to improve the lives of donkeys in desperate need. Every pound raised helps us to make a difference.

Alternative to fundraising

We understand that it can be difficult to ask your friends, family and colleagues for sponsorship, and maybe you don't have the time to hold a fundraising event. If you don't want to go down this route, you can choose to pay a donation when you sign up instead. We ask for a minimum of £25 per person, which is in addition to your sign-up fee. 100% of this donation will go towards the work of the charity.

SET A TARGET

Setting a target is a really effective way to get the message across

£20 Will pay one donkey's annual wormer

£45 Will fund one donkey to have annual vaccinations

£100 Can help pay for two donkeys to have annual dental checks

£200 Can help pay for the farrier for one donkey for a year

Covers the cost of 100 bales of straw for feed and bedding for one donkey for a year









Sponsorship JustGiving

Just Giving is an online platform for fundraising.

You will receive a dedicated link to your fundraising page, which you can then email to friends, family and colleagues as well as sharing the link to your Facebook, Linkedin or other social media platforms. Here is how to set up a Just Giving Page:

- 1. Visit www.justgiving.com/campaign/dawdlefordonkeys2020 and click 'Start fundraising'.
- 2. Click on 'Organised Event' and 'Dawdle for Donkeys'.
- 3. Choose your fundraising page web address and 'Create your page'. Once your page is set up you are ready to share your link and accept donations
