**ENDOCRINOLOGY** – If submitting for ACTH please note we run ACTH on Tuesdays and Fridays. ACTH is run on EDTA plasma. Ideally this should be spun down and plasma only posted with an ice pack for next day delivery, Monday to Thursday only. We DO NOT recommend freezing the EDTA plasma before sending. We often freeze plasma and serum on arrival and the effects of thawing and re-freezing EDTA plasma on ACTH concentration are largely unknown. Old or un-chilled samples may not be run.

**PARASITOLOGY** – A full faecal profile requires 40g of dung. If an insufficient amount of sample is submitted the lungworm test will not be run. Please specify above if the lungworm test is essential. Pooled samples are of limited diagnostic value and will therefore NOT be tested.
